### Crystal Corona Earrings with Nettie Varnell

**40 bicone crystal beads-4 mm  
size 11 or 15 Japanese seed beads  
#12 beading needle**

**Fireline 6lb test**

**1 pair earwires, also bring scissors, round nose pliers, work surface, task light and magnifiers if you need them.** These pretty earrings look like little wreaths – hmmm..can you say "Holiday ideas"?
