# General Meeting March 19, 2012

Pearl Knotting with Tamara Prudhomme

Supplies needed are:

1 strand 5.5 - 6 mm pearls (you can get 2 bracelets or one necklace from this strand)

**#2 Natural Silk** (I use Bead Cord Perlseide - it comes prepackaged with 2 meters of silk with an attached needle) **Fishhook Clasp-**or a lightweight clasp of choice.

French wire (only 1 to 1 1/2 inches is needed)

An awl or long-fine needle, fine tipped tweezers, beading mat or towel to keep pearls from rolling (use a towel or mat that is lighter or darker than the silk and pearl color)small scissors to cut silk and a bead reamer.

Traditional pearls are white or off white and use white silk. Today you can get pearls and silk that are many different colors. A very contemporary look is to use white pearls with black or colored silk.

I'll be demonstrating how to start the project and how to knot with the single needle and thread method. The ending of the project is the same as the beginning but I don't think anyone will be able to finish the project in an hour. I will include instructions as soon as I make them up.

It's really important with this method to get the silk with the <u>attached</u> needle otherwise there may be difficulties getting the needle through the pearl holes with 2 strands of this size silk.
