Double Half-Hitch Knot Bracelet

This month, precious Paula Knauber will instruct us in the creation of a lovely seed bead bracelet. This is a perfect project for newcomers to beading, not to mention fun for anyone!

To make this project you will need to bring:

½ Tube of size 6/0 or 8/0 Seed Beads

20 6mm or 8mm Bi-Cones or Firepolish Beads
1 Large Lobster Claw Clasp w/Soldier or Split Ring
54"(or more) of S-Lon Cord, or any cord that will

pass through your beads.

Tools: Scissors and thread burner if you have one.
Other items that you may want to bring: pen/pencil, paper, ruler/measuring tape, glasses/magnifier, task light, extension cord and personal hand tools. Question? contact Paula-995-9717 or Lynn Burres-429-1409
