Even Count Peyote Stitch bracelet with Eleanor Cutts

Come to the meeting prepared to stitch the night away!
Our own elegant Eleanor will guide you along the peyote
pathway. This is a great "entry level" seed bead project,
and a fine warm up for retreat classes. To participate you
will need-

Size 8 Hex Cut seed beads-1 or 2 colors

Size 12 beading needles

Fireline bead thread (6lb)

Be sure to bring **scissors, bead mat, task light** and
magnifiers if you need them.

There is no kit available, but you can get your supplies
locally from **The Danish Princess in Milton.**
