Beaded Purse Charm with Susan Molloy

Looking for a quick and fun project to use up some of those pesky extra beads you have? Scintillating Susan will teach us how to make a purse charm using eye pins, bead caps, chain, spacers and beads, and show you several finished pieces to inspire you. Just in case you have no pesky beads lying around (hee hee), she will have kits of findings and beads you may purchase for \$2 each. If bringing your own you will need:

91/2"link chain approx. (cut 1-1/2", 2", 2-1/2, and 4

2" eve pins- 7

6 mm jump rings-2

4mm jump rings- 1

4mm or 5mm bead cap, basket or cone shaped-1 4mm bead spacer- 4

Lobster clasp- 1-3/4" (20mm)

Focal bead: no more than 18mm (Susan will offer owl, fish, birds, and rondels)

Accent beads-any amount in any style and size to complement your charm.

Tools to bring: flat and round nose pliers, wire cutters. Nylon jaw pliers and jump ring closing piers are optional. Work surface, task light and magnifiers are always helpful too.
