## CLASS – SANTA FE SUSHI – MAY 16th

Join **Diana Sue Yum-Bucher** as she teaches Mary Waterloo Smith's *Santa Fe Sushi*. For this project with that fusion of New Mexican and Japanese feel, you will need to bring:

*Supplies:* 1 bead with a hole big enough for 20 gauge wire. (See following photos for size and shape ideas.)

3 colors of size 6 seed beads (Also known as E beads.)
20 gauge wire, dead soft (1 foot is plenty.)
24 gauge wire, dead soft (3 yards is plenty.)
18 and 16 gauge wire are used for connector rings, but you do not need to have them for this class.

*<u>Tools</u>*: Wire cutters, needle nose pliers, round nose pliers, task light, bead mat, and eye protection is recommended.
