This would be a fun craft to share with a young friend, daughter/grand-daughter to help inspire them to get involved in helping the environment or just enjoy making several of these pretty and lightweight bracelets for friends/family.



MATERIALS LIST:

- _ 28 pull tabs
- _ 24 aluminum jump rings (15mm or 16mm)
- _ 2, 12mm jump rings to attach clasp
- _ Lobster claw clasp or other kind if preferred

TOOLS:

- _ flat nose pliers to open/close jump rings
- _ Jewelry file or emery paper to remove any sharp edges
- _ work surface
- _ task light
